GOSPEL



Reading of the holy gospel according to Saint Mark (1,29-39)

On leaving the synagogue Jesus entered the house of Simon and Andrew with James and John. Simon's mother-in-law lay sick with a fever. They immediately told him about her. He approached, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Then the fever left her and she waited on them.

When it was evening, after sunset, they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons. The whole town was gathered at the door. He cured many who were sick with various diseases, and he drove out many demons, not permitting them to speak because they knew him.

Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed. Simon and those who were with him pursued him and on finding him said, "Everyone is looking for you." He told them, "Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come." So he went into their synagogues, preaching and driving out demons throughout the whole of Galilee.

Today's Gospel presents the healing, by Jesus, of Peter's mother-in-law and then of many other sick and suffering people who crowded together with Him.

That of Peter's mother-in-law is the first physical healing recounted by Mark. There is a lot of sweetness in this simple act, which seems almost natural. The healing power of Jesus meets no resistance; and the healed person resumes his normal life, immediately thinking about others and not about himself, and this

is significant, it is a sign of true health! Bend over to make the other person stand up. Let's not forget that the only legal way to look at a person from top to bottom is when you extend your hand to help them up. The only one. And this

is the mission that Jesus has entrusted to the Church. The Son of God manifests his Lordship not "from above downwards", not from a distance, but by bowing down, extending his hand; He manifests his Lordship in closeness, tenderness and compassion. Closeness, tenderness, compassion are God's style.

Today's Gospel also reminds us that this compassion has its roots in the intimate relationship with the Father. Because? Before dawn and after dusk, Jesus would go away and remain alone to pray. From there he drew the strength to fulfill his ministry, preaching and healing.

Looking through the gospel of today, Jesus had set his foot to those who are least, last, and lost. Indeed, the heart of Jesus flows to those who are in need of

His salvation; His goodness attracts those who are broken, tortured by daily cruelty, left, and forgotten. The healing he has always brought forth is not limited to physical relief, but was a healing of doubt, anxiety, guilt, and all that weighs us down. He is the cure; a strengthening of ourselves that gives us a lift to conquer today. His purpose of healing and enlightenment still happens

today. The church, his instrument of peace, is the people of healing. The peace of heart, mind, and soul people find in prayer through the teachings of the

church is the ministry of Jesus; thus the lift of the soul in deep human sympathy shares the ministry of Christ. In our everyday living filled with dilemma, how can we be instrument of God's healing?
