Reading of the holy gospel according to Saint Mark (1, 40-45)

A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. Then, warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once. He said to him, "See that you tell no one anything, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses prescribed; that will be proof for them." The man went away and began to publicize the whole matter. He spread the report abroad

so that it was impossible for Jesus to enter a town openly. He remained outside in deserted places, and people kept coming to him from everywhere.

In this short and apparently simple story Jesus is approached by a leper whom he heals. Jesus sends the leper back to receive the certification of the priest as to his being made clean and able to reenter his community.

When the leper came to Jesus and begged him to be clean, Jesus didn't hesitate to stretch out his hand and touched him even though he knew that lepers should be avoided because anybody who touched him would also become impure. After healing the leper, Jesus said "See you say nothing to anybody, but go show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing the things which Moses commanded". The man still spread the news to everyone without even thinking and knowing the consequences that he might cause. In every actions that we make we should be mindful because it may affect to the feelings of others. Can we be mindful to all the actions that we or we just do or follow God's will?

The outstretched hand of Jesus continues to touch us in our daily lives. Above all, and most directly, we meet that touch in the sacraments of the Church: in sacramental absolution, and in holy communion. But we meet it in other ways too: in our prayer; in our holy reading; in the Saints; in other people. Sometimes we find ourselves being used as instruments of that divine touch for others.


