GOSPEL

Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Luke (2:22-40)

When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, Mary and Joseph took Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord,

Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord, and to offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons, in accordance with the dictate in the law of the Lord. Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon.

This man was righteous and devout, awaiting the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he should not see death before he had seen the Christ of the Lord. He came in the

Spirit into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to perform the custom of the law in regard to him, he took him into his arms and blessed God, saying: "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."

.The child's father and mother were amazed at what was said about him; and Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted - and you yourself a sword will pierce- so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed." There was also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years, having lived seven years with her husband after her marriage, and then as a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple, but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer. And coming forward at that very time, she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem. When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.

REFLECTION

The reading of the gospel according to Saint Luke immerses us in a transcendental event: the presentation of Jesus in the temple. Filled with symbolism and hope, this passage offers profound insight into how our faith and daily practice can be enriched and enlivened.

Simeon, a just and pious man, symbolizes patient and faith-filled waiting. His life is a testimony of hope and perseverance, essential qualities in our pastoral work and in apostolic movements. Simeon's prophecy about Jesus illuminates the path of the church: to be a light for the nations and glory for his people. However, he also warns of challenges, symbolized in the "sword" that will pierce Mary's soul.

This passage invites us to live our faith actively, not only in church but also in our daily lives. Every act of kindness, every moment of patience, and every word of comfort are ways of practicing our faith.

The presentation of Jesus and the words of Simeon are an invitation to reflect on our faith and act accordingly. They encourage us to be bearers of hope and light in our environment, following the example of Jesus and his parents. In this first perspective, Simeon's wise word expresses the certainty that life overcomes death, despite complex circumstances and our temporal limitation. That is, God's time is auspicious time. A true Kairos. Its promise is the emergence of a genuine light in the midst of pain, which must be reborn in our hearts as the certainty of the arrival of a new perspective and a new way of relationships, even though we feel that our human strengths or limitations do not allow us to do so. further. So many dear people that we have lost in these times make it necessary to recognize that in the midst of that pain there is a light ahead that calls us not to give up, despite our fragility.

No one is absolutely certain of what tomorrow holds for us, which is why it is about embracing life with all our strength at this moment, and beginning to create new possibilities of hope, of the Kingdom, with the certainty that the new light that God himself has promised us in Jesus is born and reborn from fragility and from the margins for everyone. It is time to make everything new in the sense of justice, solidarity and fraternity, and that there be space for all who assume this call to weave life and life in abundance, in the key of integral liberation.
